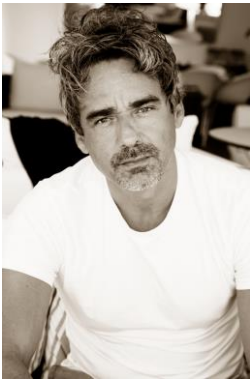


# Almir Reis
